

Final results of application process for doctoral studies in management and economics at Warsaw School of Economics

Introductory note

Below you will find four tables listing respectively unsuccessful and successful candidates who applied for full and part-time studies.

For each type of studies a separate ranking list was compiled and the best 30 candidates were offered a place in our PhD programme. Those applicants whose scores ranked them below 30th place were deemed unsuccessful and couldn't be admitted.

Scores for interviews were assigned based on the consensus of opinions of academic staff who participated in respective interviews. The maximum score to be earned here was 30.

Grade for the examination in economics was initially established on a scale of 0 through 30 points, with each correctly answered question earning 1 point. Then, as per regulations of the recruitment procedure, the results were rescaled by multiplying each of them by 2/3 to arrive at a set of scores expressed on a scale with a maximum of 20.

Tentative research proposals were assessed by a panel of three academic staff members of the Collegium of World Economy on a typical academic scale used at Polish universities starting with 3, as the lowest grade, signifying acceptable but not good quality of work and ending with 5 for proposals of exceptionally high value. The mean of partial grades was calculated and the resulting averages were multiplied by 10. As a result, each grade was expressed on a scale with the minimum of 30 and the maximum of 50 points.
