## LIST OF DOCUMENTS TO ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION ABOUT THE RECTOR'S SCHOLARSHIP:

1) the course of studies for the last year of first-cycle studies and information on the scale of grades at the university – in the case of students applying for the Rector's scholarship for the first year of second-cycle studies, if they have completed first-cycle studies at a university other than SGH;

<u>NOTE:</u> you must provide a course sheet (with all grades, from all approaches to the exams, not just the final grade). <u>DIPLOMA SUPPLEMENT IS NOT ACCEPTED!!!</u>

The course of studies must be signed and stamped by an authorized employee of the University (self-printing from the university system without the signature of the University employee is not accepted).

2) a certificate from the publisher about the publication of the reviewed book (with the name and academic degree of the reviewer) written by the student, or a photocopy of the title page and footer with the ISBN number;

3) a certificate from the publisher about the publication of the reviewed book (with the name and academic degree of the reviewer) containing the chapter authored by the student;

4) a certificate from the publisher about the publication of the article written by the student in the journal or the first page of the article with the given ISSN number together with if there is no ISSN number on the first page of the article – a photocopy of the journal footer with this number;

5) the conference programme with the list of participants and a certificate from the conference organizer, which will include: the date of the conference, the title of the presented paper or poster;

6) a certificate from the publisher of the publication of the electronic publication, authored by the student, on physical media (e. g. CD-ROM, DVD-ROM) with the ISBN number, publisher number or a photocopy of the cover of the publication allowing to determine authorship and year of publication;

7) an online publication certificate confirming the electronic publication on the website of which the student is the author, with the ISSN number of the electronic journal, the name of the author, the title and the date of publication;

8) a certificate from the publisher about the publication of an art book written by a student, or a photocopy of the title page and footer with the ISBN number;

9) a certificate from the publishing house on the inclusion of the artistic work of which the student is the author in the collective publication or a photocopy of the title page and footer with the ISBN number and additionally the title page of the chapter with the name of the author or the table of contents with the title of the chapter and the name of the author;

10) a certificate or diplomas confirming that the student has taken a point-based place in scientific or artistic competitions/festivals;

11) certificates or diplomas confirming the occupancy of points by the student in scientific competitions and art competitions/festivals of international or national scope;

12) a certificate from the organizer of the exhibition about the exhibition of the artistic work of which the student is the author, in an exhibition of international or national scope;

13) certificates or diplomas confirming the occupancy of points by the student at international or national sporting events;

14) a certificate confirming the fact that the student is a laureate or medalist of the International Olympiad (**applies to students admitted to the first year of studies in the year of the matriculation examination**);

15) a certificate of the Main Committee of the Olympiad stating that the student is a laureate or finalist of the central degree of the Polish national Olympiad (**applies to students admitted to the first year of studies in the year of submission of the matriculation examination**);

16) a certificate from the relevant Polish Sports Association stating the fact of being a medalist of at least a sports competition for the title of Polish Champion in a given sport, referred to in the sports regulations (**applies to students admitted to the first year of studies in the year of submission of the matriculation examination**).
