Showcase Assignment is aimed to support and demonstrate students' civic engagement in two ways:

- by reflecting on their experience of the CIVICA Engage track, students become aware of their transformative learning for their civic engagement:
  - →identify a problem of social importance and express your point of view on that problem, resulting from your studies and/or personal experience;
  - → discuss a solution maybe suggest your own?



Showcase Assignment is aimed to support and demonstrate students' civic engagement in two ways:

- students can bring their unique learning experiences about key public issues,
  to an external audience of their choice.
  - → the audience may be e.g. your fellow students, academic community of your university, local or national government, EU governing bodies, a targeted group (eg. employers in some sector of the economy) or the general public you should simply adjust your showcase assignment to the external audience of your choice.



#### Showcase Assignment – two components:

- a personal analytical reflection on students' learning through CIVICA that covers both what they learned and how they learned;
- in a short media piece, students tell one story about their learning and how it addresses (using social sciences concepts) a European challenge.
- The format of this piece is open (a short film, podcast, an interview, multimedia presentation, research article, blog with embedded links to relevant materials, conference speech...).
- Media piece components of the showcase assignments may be published on mycivica.eu upon the students' consent.



#### Showcase Assignment – what elements to include? – suggestions:

- 1. Use the concepts discussed within the framework of your CIVICA Engage course or the European Week.
- 2. Present your own point of view on a European challenge.
- 3. Share your experience of the CIVICA Engage course/European Week what were the most valuable elements of this experience? How did the CIVICA experience change your point of view on the given problem? How will you use this knowledge in the future?
- 4. What are the most important insights you would like to share with the audience of your choice?



#### Assessment of the Showcase Assignment

- Time for presentation: up to 15 minutes;
- pass or fail;
- deadline in the summer semester 2023/24 May 31 st, 2024.
