

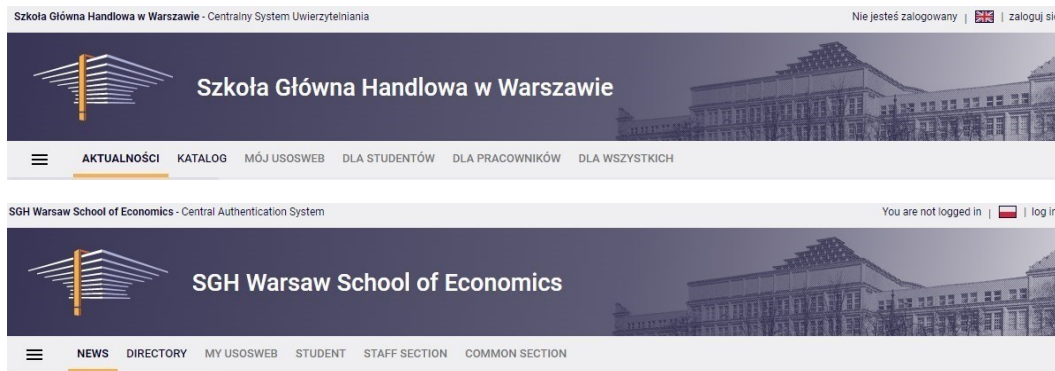

General information

To access the USOSweb registrations you need to log in to: <https://usosweb.sgh.waw.pl/>

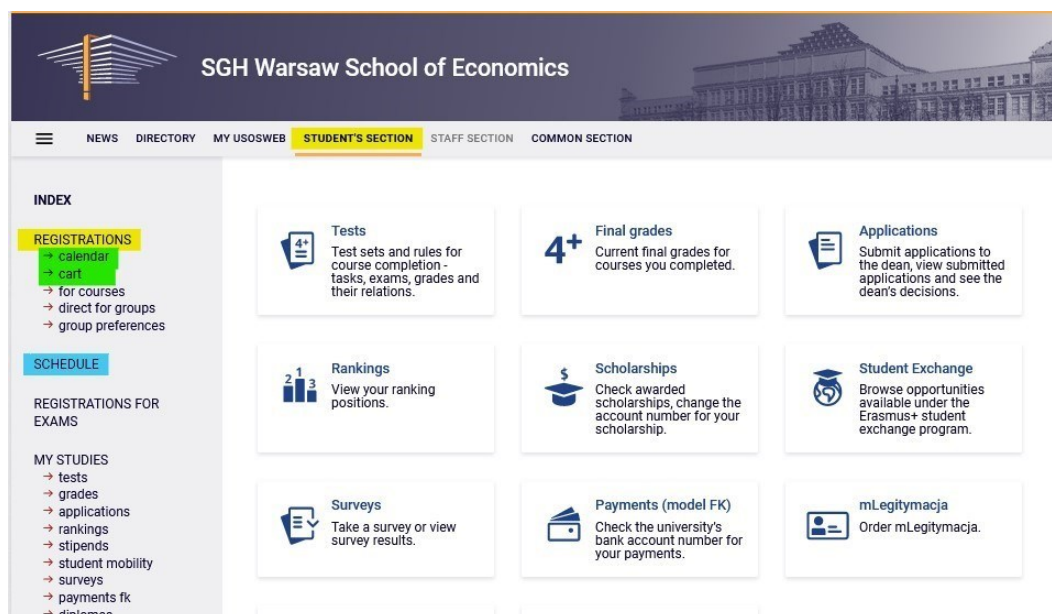
NOTE: Do not use auto translation (e.g.: provided by the web browser), please switch the languages using the flag visible in the upper right corner.



Then you need to go to the **STUDENT'S SECTION** tab, where all registration activities take place.

Depending on the specifics of a given round, the following are used:

- **Calendar** - from which you go to registration round, either for classes or for seminars; (**calendar** shows all available registrations for a given student).
- **Cart** - shows courses for which the student is currently enrolled.
- **Schedule** - in addition to the current student's timetable, it shows the changes introduced on an ongoing basis in courses during registration.

Registration for courses:

Second round - registration to groups based on ranking.

This round is only available to people who have taken part in **the Preferences** (other people will be able to register for classes from the next round).

During this round, all launched for the next semester are available, but some places in groups are already filled after earlier rounds. Students enrolled in groups (even before the beginning of this round) will not be subject to the ranking, their places are already guaranteed.

Therefore, it may happen at the beginning of this turn that some courses will already have their slot limits filled. Students will have at their disposal a free part of the places - to fill **the upper limit**.

In this round, you do not register directly for classes, but only send requests for admission to the course group of your choice. Until the round closes, you can withdraw the request and give up the course or send a request for the same course but to a different class group.

NOTE - You cannot deregister from classes that you have entered in the Cart at the beginning of the turn.

Requests for admission to classes can be sent exceeding the **upper limit of** places in the group. However, only the number of students that does not exceed the limit of places will be accepted and therefore after the completion of this part of the registration the round will be recalculated:

1. In the case of groups in which the limit of places will not be reached or will be filled, all those who have submitted a request for admission will be accepted and will be guaranteed a place in these groups until the end of the entire registration period (selected subjects will become binding for them to be completed in the semester)
2. In groups where the set limit is exceeded, places will be awarded based on the ranking and established rules (bonuses), i.e.:
 1. For subjects taught in English, students who study in English will have added bonuses added to the ranking.
 2. Added bonuses added to the ranking will have students who register for their last semester and for whom a given subject is needed for graduation.
 3. Added bonuses added to the ranking will have students for whom a given subject will be mandatory in the semester for which they register for classes.

Therefore, it is good to keep in mind your **potential position** in the group (in relation to **the upper limit of** places).

Since the ranking with bonuses is recalculated on an ongoing basis, your position during the round may change all the time, depending on whether other students (with a higher position in the ranking) apply for admission to the class or withdraw from it.

Therefore, it is worth considering whether to send a request for enrollment to a group in which there is a smaller number of students applying, so that after the conversion of the turn you have a better chance of being admitted to classes.

In this round you use the **Calendar, Cart and Schedule will be also useful:**

Filters

After returning to the Calendar, go to registration and you can make requests for admission to the courses of your choice. If you want to find items from a specific category, it is a good idea to use the available filters:

1. When searching by course number, enter a maximum of six digits (do not enter four digits after the dash) or the first digits of the number – then you will see all the courses that begin with those digits.
2. When searching by the name, you can enter only part of it – then you will see all the courses that have the phrase entered in their name.

In the same way, you can also search for courses for your field of study, but it is easier to search for them using filters, because then you will get a list of every course regardless of the course number and name.

When using filters, pay attention to the fact that some filters may give you an empty result.

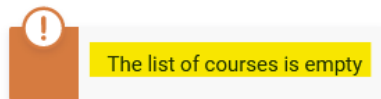

NOTE: the filter “**show mandatory courses for the next semester**” applies to mandatory courses in a given semester of studies of your major, listed in the study plan in the [curriculum](#) of your major.

Registering for courses from this filter does not equal to submitting a valid declaration for a given semester (it is also necessary to declare enough ECTS credits, usually 30 per semester, and check your declaration with the appropriate guide - i.e., the [curriculum](#) issued for the year you have started your major).

If you choose the filter “**show major courses**” (the filter does not show the requirements for a specific semester, only the requirements for the implementation of all major courses for a given major) – you will see a list of **major courses**:

ATTENTION STUCENTS REGISTERING FOR CLASSES ON THEIR LAST SEMETER

In the case of the last semester, the schedule does not include specific course, but because this is the last semester in which you are obliged to complete all previously failed major subjects and obtain 15 ECTS/20 ECTS points in Major Electives selecting this filter will show you all previously unrealized major and major electives on the list of courses related to the field of study, which you haven't done yet.

However, if you have already completed or currently passing Major Electives, you should choose at least enough of these courses to obtain the required 15 ECTS/20 ECTS after the end of the semester.

However, if you have already completed needed for 15 ECTS/20 ECTS in Major Electives, you do not have to choose any items from this pool.

In the last semester in the case of major subjects, it will be simpler to use the filter:
