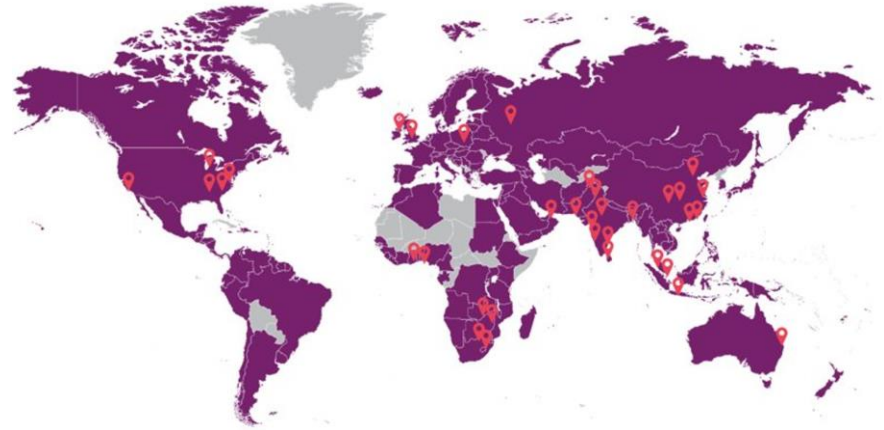
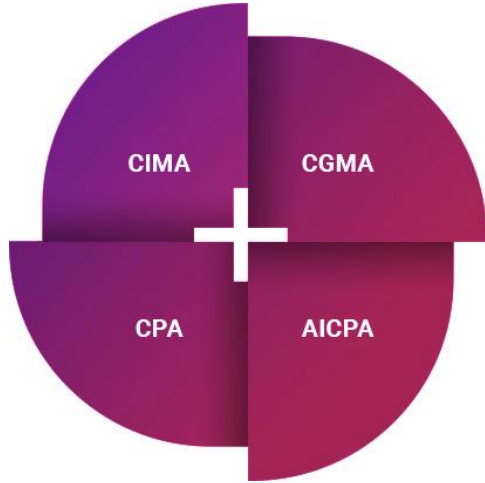

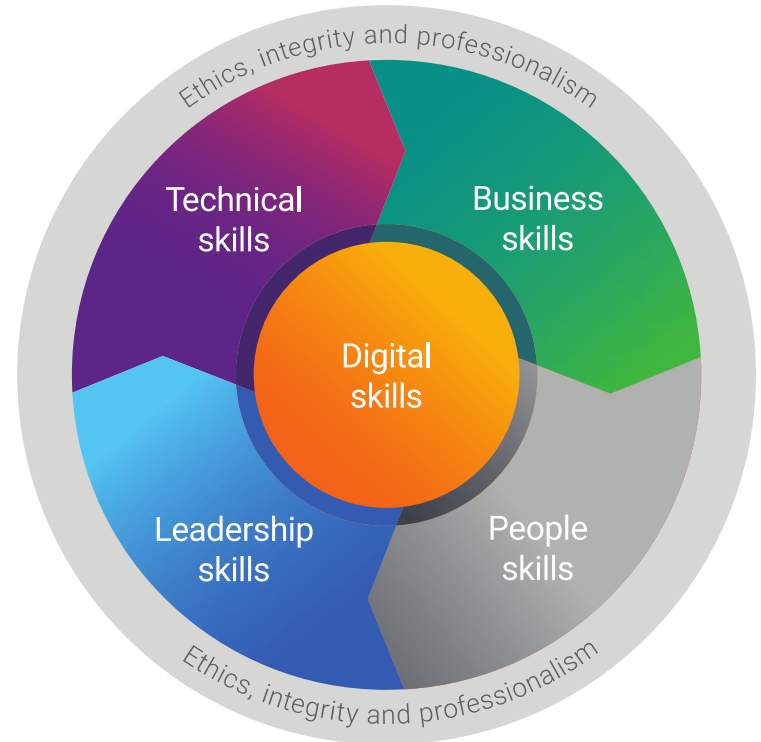


CGMA Competency Framework empowers students to become business partners

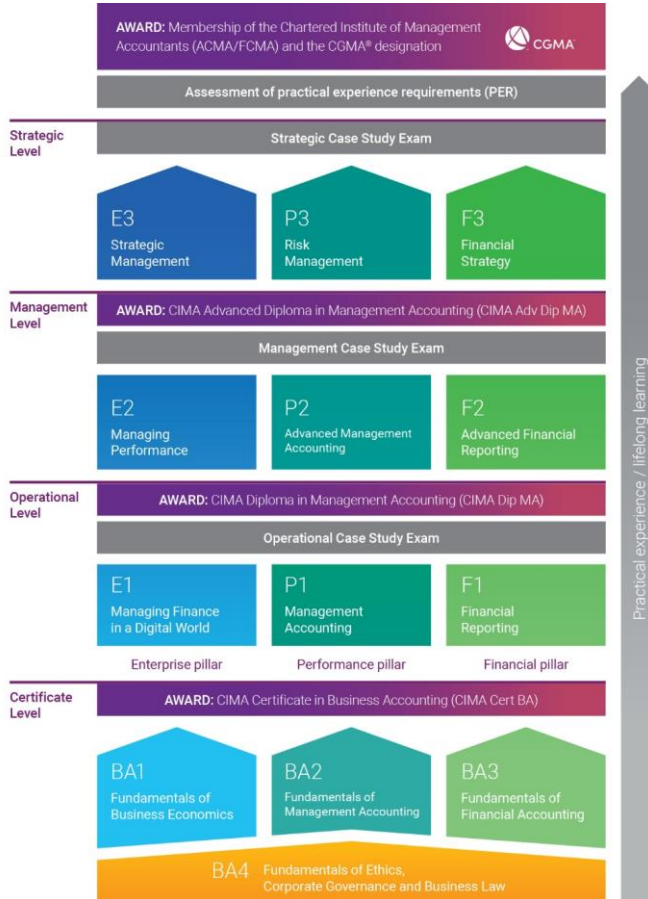
The CGMA Competency Framework is based on feedback **from employers worldwide** and provides a structure to identify and evaluate **key skills and competencies** that companies want their people to develop.

The CGMA Competency Framework integrates **technical, business, people and leadership** skills. This interconnection highlights key skills such as **collaboration, integration and synthesis**.

It underpins the syllabus and content in the CGMA Program.

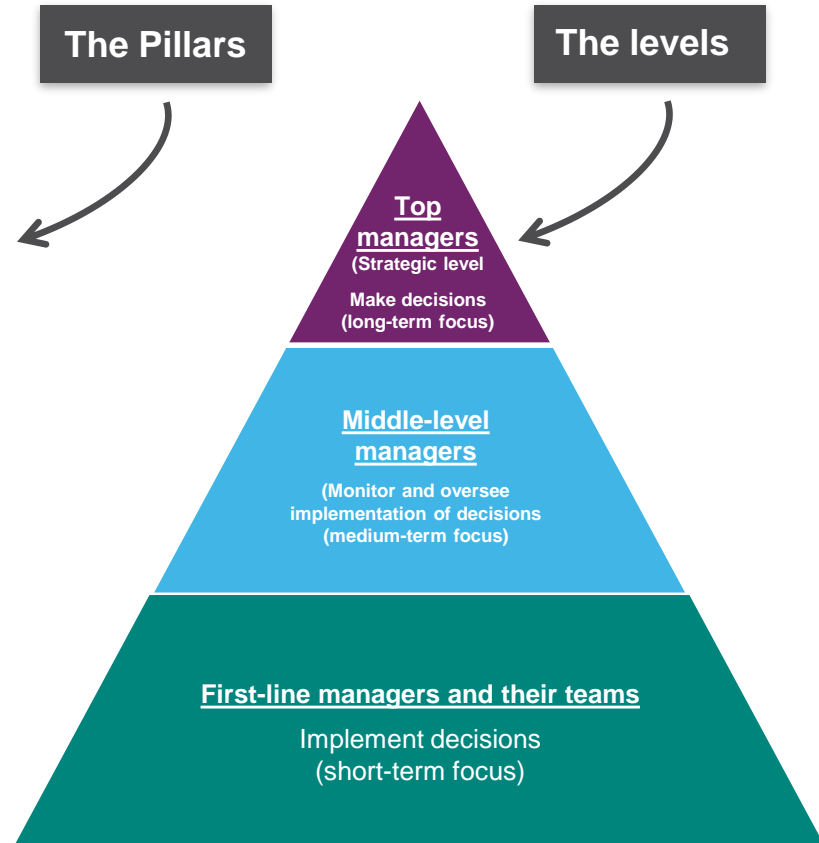

The pillars

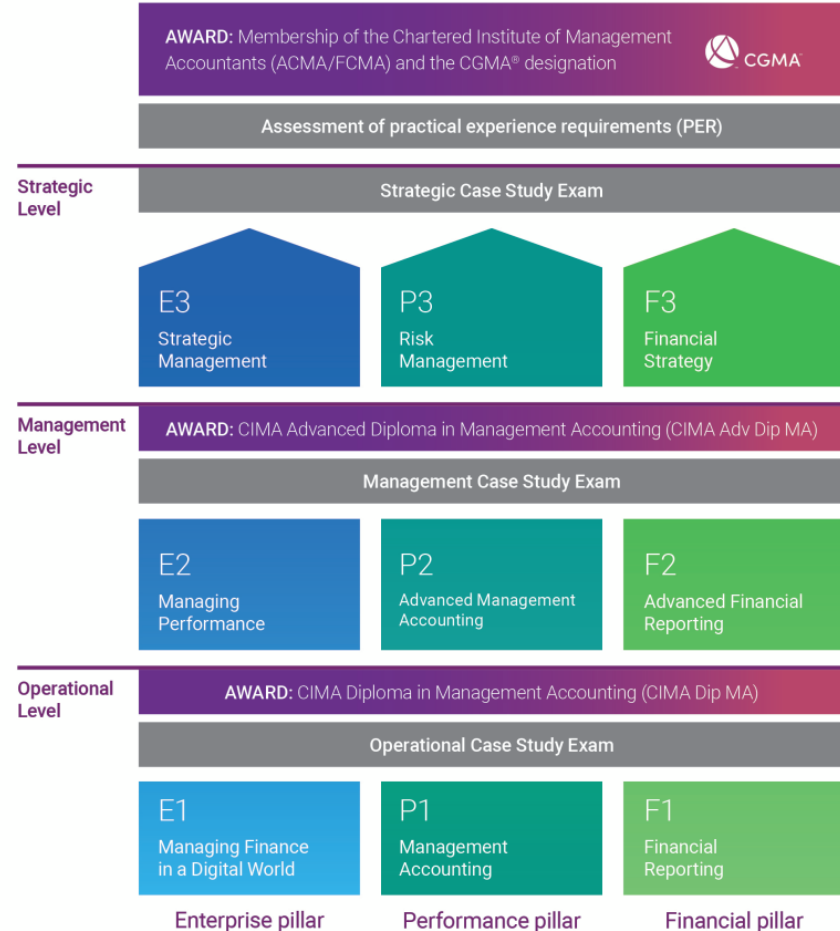
These three pillars are designed to cover finance and a range of other business areas.

- **The Enterprise Pillar** — Develop and implement strategies.
- **The Performance Pillar** — Track activities and ensure that strategies are realistic and effective.
- **The Financial Pillar** — Prepare and understand financial statements to keep an eye on performance and inform company decisions.

The levels

These three levels encourage progressive, constant development of knowledge, ensuring you have the skills businesses need:

- **The operational level** focuses on short-term decision-making. It mirrors the work of first-line managers and their teams.
- **The management level** focuses on translating long-term decisions into medium-term plans. It reflects the work of middle-managers.
- **The strategic level** focuses on long-term strategic decision-making and providing resources to implement these successfully. Senior management takes on this level.



Examinations

Objective Tests for the CGMA Certificate in Business Accounting and Professional Qualification are available on-demand, all year round. Professional Qualification Case Study exams are available four times a year.

CGMA University Program in short:

- AICPA & CIMA partners with the best economic universities in Europe.
- Study the CGMA qualification as part of your degree, whether you're a full-time or part-time student.
- Available for Bachelor, Master and postgraduate students.
- Program aligned with the CGMA syllabus.
- Study towards your degree and upon passing all your university exams you will be granted exemptions from certain CGMA exams.
- Minimum 1 external exam.
- All exams in the program are in English and at least a B2 (CEFR upper intermediate) level is required.
- Advance your studies by gaining professional qualification in management accounting for a competitive edge in the job market.
- Start your journey to international success with the CGMA designation.



How the Program works?

The CGMA University Program is implemented as interdisciplinary specialty programmes at SGH Warsaw School of Economics. Students who complete all required courses are exempt from specific CGMA exams, and after passing the final external exam, they can obtain a CGMA designation at three levels:

- Certificate level: Certificate in Business Accounting (CGMA Cert BA)
- Operational level: Diploma in Management Accounting (CIMA Dip MA)
- Management level: Advanced Diploma in Management Accounting (CIMA Adv Dip MA)

Conditions of participation

CGMA University Program enables you to start studying the CGMA qualification as part of your degree, whether you're a full-time or part-time student.

- **First-cycle (Bachelor) studies – Certificate level (Cert BA)**
Between the 3rd and 5th semester

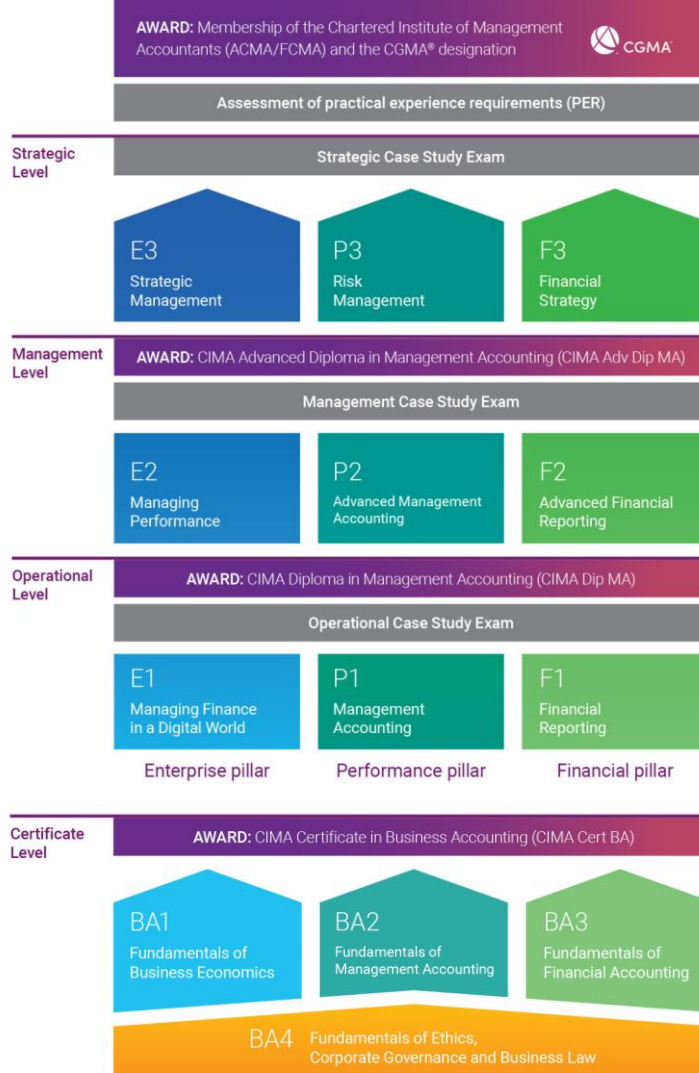

STEP

3

Become a CGMA candidate.

Register with us and pay a one-time registration fee, which includes initial registration, a credit to sit one CGMA exam and your first year's subscription fee.

All CGMA University Program participants are full-fledged CGMA candidates with all the global and local benefits.

STEP

4

Schedule your exams.

Study towards your degree, upon passing all your university exams, you will be granted exemptions from certain CGMA exams.

All you have to do to receive your CIMA diploma is to pass one or more external exams, depending on your university course.
