<p>Project title: Water for All – Environment-Friendly Water Dispensers in SGH Buildings</p>
<p>Applicant(s): Jan Górski</p>
<p>Why is the project important? (no more than 100 words)</p> <p>The project addresses the need to limit plastic consumption at the School, promoting environment-friendly habits. Water dispensers will ensure easy access to free, clean water for the health and convenience of students, doctoral students and academic staff. This will also decrease single-use bottle waste.</p>
<p>Project description (no more than 250 words)</p> <p>The project will involve installing one water dispenser on each floor of the main buildings at the School. The units will be equipped with filters (no bottle), using water in standard 18.9-litre bottles, ensuring high-quality water. The activities will involve: (1) consultations with the administrative authorities as to the location of the dispensers; (2) the purchase and installation of the dispensers; (3) an information campaign on the benefits of the project. Implementation of the project will take three months. The project is affordable and low-maintenance, offering long-term benefits.</p>
