Project title: Share room

Why is the project important? (no more than 100 words)

The Share Room project involves creating a space at SGH where students and staff can share items which they do not use any more, such as books, tools or miscellaneous household items. Everyone could bring something and take what they need for free. The initiative promotes the idea of sharing, reduces consumption, and at the same time supports the implementation of circular economy principles while building a community based on trust and care for the environment.

Project description (no more than 250 words)

To implement the project, SGH must give its consent, and a room must be allocated for the purpose of the project. Then, the room has to be equipped with shelves and containers, and Share Room Terms of Use have to be drafted. The next step is promoting the initiative across the School, through social media, posters, and information events. Lastly, a team of volunteers has to be appointed to ensure that the Share Room remains orderly, items are rotated, and efforts are coordinated on an ongoing basis.
