What distinguishes SGH Warsaw School of Economics from other universities in Poland?

SGH is the oldest and most prestigious economic university in Poland, as well as one of the best universities of this profile in Europe. Its staff comprises the best Polish and foreign specialists in the field of economics, finance and management. SGH is a guarantee of high-quality classes, both in terms of teaching standards and the imparted knowledge, while the emphasis on developing practical skills helps students to adapt to the needs of the rapidly changing economic reality.

SGH in rankings

In the Perspektywy University Ranking 2024, SGH topped the economic university category. Ranking by field of study: first place – Finance and Accounting, second place – Economics and Information Technology and Econometrics, third place – Management. Among all universities included in the ranking, SGH secured twelfth place in the general ranking. We are among the highest-rated business universities in Poland, according to the Eduniversal ranking, where we received the “5 Palmes of Excellence” for 2024. In the latest ranking of an esteemed Polish daily *Rzeczpospolita*, which assessed the quality of teaching, internationalisation, alumni career and scientific potential, SGH claimed the top spot for the fourth consecutive year among economic universities and faculties.

International cooperation

SGH has always been open to exchanging knowledge and sharing teaching and research experience with other academic centres. SGH cooperates with about 300 universities all over the world and takes part in research activities conducted in collaboration with centres abroad. Each year academics from various countries visit SGH to attend seminars and conferences, give lectures and participate in joint research projects. SGH is involved in several international programmes for staff and students alike, including double degree programmes offered in cooperation with 15 partner universities. Every year, nearly 500 SGH students complete parts of their curricula abroad. As the only Polish CEMS Academic Member School, SGH also offers the prestigious CEMS Master's in International Management programme.

Orientation Week

Did you know that...

- SGH is located close to the centre of Warsaw (the capital of Poland) with excellent access to public transport – the metro station, bus and tram stops, as well as a city bike rental station, all located nearby.
- SGH campus consists of eight buildings located several hundred metres from one another. A few minutes' walk is enough to move from one site to another.
- Students may apply for accommodation in two SGH Student Houses located within walking distance from the campus. They may also choose to rent a nice studio apartment in one of the locations recommended by SGH.
- The SGH Library is the largest economic library in Poland. Its beautiful and spacious reading room may accommodate up to 200 students at the same time.
- SGH is located only 200 metres away from Pole Mokotowskie – one of the largest parks in Warsaw, a paradise for nature lovers and an ideal spot away from the noise of the city. This is where students recharge their batteries between classes.
