I would like to take this opportunity to strongly encourage all those present to register for the Honour Seminars, which are being organised by the partner universities of the CIVICA Alliance during the winter semester. Details of the topics and dates of specific classes can be found below. Please be advised that the costs of travel to the cities in which the following universities are based, as well as accommodation and meals on site, are covered by the Warsaw School of Economics and the respective partner university. The classes are conducted in a block format and span five days.

Applicants may select all or only a subset of the available classes, though it should be noted that, for reasons of eligibility, only one class may be chosen

We will inform interested persons of the results of the recruitment process within two days.

In the event that the number of applicants exceeds the number of available places, a selection procedure will be employed based on the average grade achieved during the Master's programme, in a manner analogous to that used in the process of declaring subjects. Furthermore, I reserve the right to give preferential treatment to those who participated in the *Honor Seminar* organized by SGH in the summer semester of the previous academic year, in accordance with the declarations submitted at that time.

Should you be selected for the trip, you will be permitted to take the examination on a zero date in the event that the scheduled departure date coincides with an examination in the course you are currently enrolled in.
